Seating will be assigned on a First Come, First Served basis. Any unassigned seats will be assigned from a backup list based on registration email time. A seat can be assigned to a school student, teacher coach, etc.

  - 5) Indicate if you will require a lab computer or will bring your own laptop
  - 6) Name up to two (2) backup students for each session.
  - 7) Indicate roll backup student(s) (school student, teacher, coach, etc.)

# Class Information

- There will be two sessions with a lunch break between sessions. The sessions will be held Saturday, August 21, 2010 at Calhoun Community College, Decatur, AL in room 115 of the Noble Russell Building.
- The first session (9:00am to 11:30am) introduction to SolidWorks including how to turn a sketch into a part.
- Lunch will be from 11:30am to 12:30pm. Lunch is not provided. We will be taking a lunch order for Subway but students may bring their lunch.
- The second session (12:30pm to 3:00pm) will cover more advanced features of SolidWorks including how to make an assembly & drawings from your parts.
- Students may register and attend either session or both. A school or organization may want to split the training and send two separate students, one to the introduction session and another to the advanced session.
- Each session will be taught by Ricky Jordan. Mr. Jordan is the President of the North Alabama SolidWorks User Group (NASWUG) in Huntsville, Alabama and currently holds the position of Senior Mechanical Design Engineer at Dynetics, Inc. in Huntsville, AL.
- Members of NASWUG are planning to be available at each session to help students as needed.
